Research Experience

Dieter Haffner has published more than 200 original scientific articles, reviews, clinical practice guidelines, editorials and book chapters. His main interests are the genetic/mechanistic exploration and treatment of rare kidney diseases (e.g. hereditary cystic kidney disease, XLH, cystinosis and CAKUT), and mineral and bone disorders in children with CKD (CKD-MBD). He headed and/or is heavily involved in several clinical trials and patient registries. His group is currently performing cell biological and animal studies on rare kidney diseases and CKD-MBD. He has been awarded more than 20 research grants and supervised more than 30 MD and PhD students.
